

FT. LOWELL DAYS

Start the day with a vintage baseball game at 10:00 a.m. on the parade grounds at the park between The Bisbee Black Sox and Tucson Sahuaros Vintage Base Ball Clubs of the Arizona Territories Vintage Base Ball League www.arizonavintagebaseball.com.

The Sibley Army tent will be on display along with the Sibley stove. Patterned upon the Indian teepee, this tent is a replica of those used by the Army during the Indian Wars.

The hospital ruins will be open to visitors with reenactors inside to interpret.

Visit the museum to see artifacts that were found on the grounds, and exhibits about the troopers, scouts and Geronimo's warriors.

Kids will enjoy "You're in the Army" now and other activities for children.

Reenactors will be stationed around the park and the ruins of the old fort.

In the adjacent neighborhood enjoy music, food and a walking tour of the old houses; visit the old Fort commissary and San Pedro Chapel. End the day with a band concert on the parade ground performed by the Old Arizona Brass Band <http://oabb.homestead.com/> at 2 p.m. playing the songs of the 1800s.
