

Checklist for Website Entries

Rules/Guidelines

- Website was created through NHD's Weebly site www.nhd.weebly.com
- The site contains no more than 1,200 visible student-composed words
- The website contains a "home page"
- The process paper and bibliography are included on the web site
- Video clips do not last longer than 45 seconds
- All content is hosted on the page (not embedded from You Tube), site is less than 100MB
- The site does not link to any externally-hosted web sites (except to download viewers)
- Links are available to all necessary plug-ins required to view content on the site

Historical Quality

- My topic fits the theme Debate and Diplomacy: Successes, Failures, Consequences
- My topic has historical significance
- My website answers the "So What?" question.
- I have provided interpretation of source information
- I have checked all my information for accuracy
- I have a thesis for my web site
- My website supports my thesis statement

Web Site Quality

- All pages within the site have links on the home page
- Navigation through the site is easy and organized to guide a viewer through the site
- The images appearing on the site are clear
- The site is organized to maximize visual impact and connection to the NHD theme

Proofreading/Editing

- I had at least one other person proofread my web site and process paper
- My process paper is less than 500 words
- I ran spell-check and looked for errors that spell-check did not catch

Bibliography

- My bibliography is separated into primary and secondary sources
- 2/3 of my sources are primary and 1/3 of my sources are secondary
- Each source has at least a two-sentence annotation
- My annotations describe how my sources influenced my project
- I named & saved my bibliography as: **BIB_MYFIRSTNAME_MYLASTNAME**
- All of my entries have a hanging indent
- My bibliography has consistent formatting

Submission

- I emailed a copy of my process paper and bibliography by the deadline for the competition to mgately@azhs.gov and will bring 3 copies of each with me to the competition
- My teacher and I registered online at www.az.nhd.org
- I have emailed the URL for the web site to mgately@azhs.gov by the deadline; one week before the competition
